Applications are invited on plain paper from research scholars desirous of undertaking **Three Months Internship** at the University of the Fraser Valley (UFV), Abbotsford, Canada, starting September 2019.

Candidates having passed Masters in Geography with a least 55 percent marks and registered for Ph.D in the area of food security, food systems development, urban rural relations, land-use policy, agricultural sustainability, nutrition, economic growth are eligible to apply. Application should be supported by bio-data and a research proposal not exceeding 1000 words (two copies each)

The number of positions available for the session starting September 2019 is: **1(one)**. Selection will be done through interview by the committee of faculty members involved in the project and evaluation of proposal by the coordinator. Selected intern will receive funding through the Queen Elizabeth-II Scholarship awarded to the UFV in partnership with Panjab University's Geography Department. It will cover air travel (economy class) monthly living allowance covering expenses on accommodation, meals, local transportation, health insurance etc as per rules of the project (listed on Global Affairs Canada website).
